

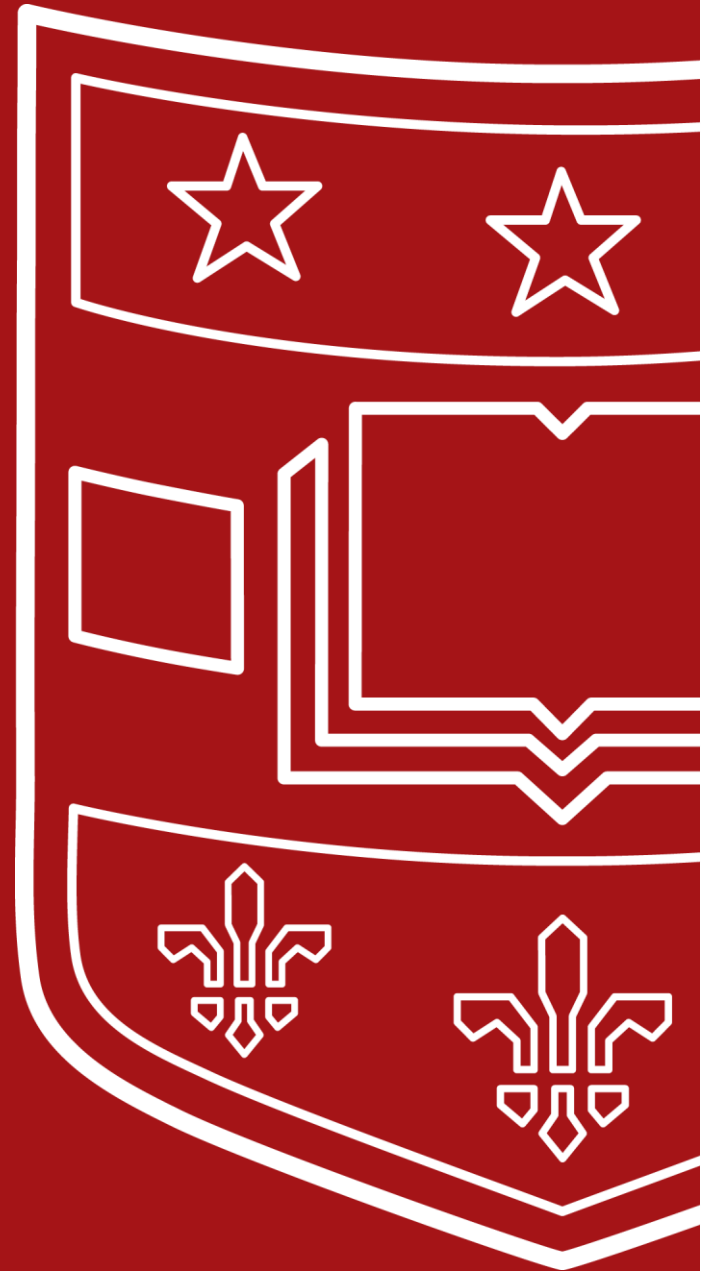

# Safety Tips when going out

- Avoid walking or jogging alone, especially after dark
- Always walk or jog in a familiar area
- Always choose a well-lit path and avoid dark or vacant areas
- Do not take shortcuts through alleys, parks or empty lots
- If you must travel alone at night, use the [Campus Circulator](#), [Campus2Home](#) or [Bear Patrol](#)
- If you exercise outdoors on a regular basis, vary your route and schedule
- Take note of the locations of the Blue Light Emergency Phones along your route
- Tell someone where you are going and when you are expected to return
- Carry a cellular telephone with you and use it if you feel unsafe

- Carry a whistle to summon help. WUPD offers free safety whistles
- Keep your hands as free as possible
- Do not wear headphones while walking or jogging. Leave at least one ear piece out
- Have your access card or keys ready when returning to your apartment

# Safety Tips when accessing buildings



- Do not lend your ID card to anyone
- Report people that “tailgate” or follow you into a building
- Do not open doors for strangers
- Do not prop open doors
